Shooting Range Rules

- 1. Always keep the gun pointed in a safe direction.
- 2. Always keep your finger off the trigger until ready to shoot.
- 3. Always keep the gun unloaded until ready to use.
- 4. Know your target and what is beyond; make sure the downrange area is unoccupied.
- 5. Know how to use the gun safely.
- 6. Be sure the gun is safe to operate.
- 7. Use only the correct ammunition for your gun.
- 8. Wear eye and ear protection as appropriate.
- 9. Never use alcohol or drugs before or while shooting.
- 10. Unattended guns should not be accessible to unauthorized persons.
