April 6 – June 22 (Picnic)

(No League on Memorial Day due to Delaware State Shoot)

Entries begin at 4:00 pm; shooting at 4:30 pm. Entries close at 7:00 pm.

TROPHIES (precedent is as follows)

First and Second *Team* Trophy

High Shooter, Runner-up Shooter

High Vet (65 – 69 years), High Senior Vet (70 years and above),

High Lady, High Junior (15 to 18 years old - see below)

4 Trophies Overall Class Winners – A, B, C, D

4 Trophies Each Team – A, B, C, D

No shooter may win more than one trophy.

GENERAL INFORMATION

*(Official Rules and other information will be available
and posted the first evening of the League)*

Per WTA's Safety Rules, all new shooters must complete WTA's Safety and Shooting Instruction training before competing. No one less than 15 years old may compete. Shooters between 15 and 18 years old, must be accompanied by a parent or guardian.

A shooter may “make up” a missed shoot the following week only. Make up scores will count toward individual trophies only (not team trophies). You must shoot seven of the ten shoots to be eligible for trophies. The top seven scores will be used if you shoot all ten weeks. All lady, junior (under 18 years old), veteran (65 years or older), and senior veteran (70 years and older) must verify their classification on the posted score sheets by the fourth week to be eligible for trophies in that category.

Should WTA Officials cancel a shoot due to inclement weather or other unforeseen circumstances, a make up shoot for that night will be scheduled or not at the Association's discretion. All scores shot prior to the official notification to shooters of cancellation, will be binding and will not be made up. No shooter may win more than one trophy.

Any shooter displaying unsafe, un-sportsman's like, or disruptive conduct will be disqualified and may be asked to leave the club property.
