



WTA Fall Handicap "Shootout"

Non Registered - 100 Handicap Targets

Shoot Date: November 22, 2008 – Rain Date December 6, 2008 (both dates are Saturdays)

Pre-entries (must be post marked 7 days before shoot): \$50.00 per shooter - \$20.00 of each entry goes to "the pot". 50 shooters must preregister to hold the shoot. If 50 shooters do not pre-enter, entry fees will be returned by mail.

Entry day of shoot (11/22 only): \$75.00 - \$25 of each entry to "the pot". Entries the day of the shoot stop at 9:30 AM (before squad draw – see below). Window opens at 8:00 AM for entries.

At 10:00 AM, entries will close and squads and positions will be assigned by random draw (first name drawn is Squad 1, Position 1, etc. – squads are by yardage (short, middle, long yardage). First squad will be called to the line at 11:00 am. Shoot will be 100 handicap targets, shot 25 per trap on 4 traps.

Payout 1: ½ "the pot" goes to the winner. Ties will be decided by shoot off – 10 targets, 2 targets to a post.

Payout 2: ½ "the pot" will be distributed as follows - a number between 0 and 9 will be drawn. All shooters whose score ends with that number will shoot off (10 targets, 2 targets to a post.) for 1st place (50 percent of ½ of the pot), 2nd place (30 percent of ½ of the pot) and 3rd place (20 percent of ½ of the pot).

Only one money payout to each shooter. The shoot is non-registered, but ATA Rules will apply. Shooters that have shot ATA registered targets in the last 5 years will shoot their current or last assigned yardage or higher based on known ability (a copy of both sides of your current ATA card must be sent with the pre-registration card or you will shoot from 27 yards). All others will shoot from 25 yards or higher based on known ability. The decision of WTA management on yardage assignment is final.

All pre-registration will be my mail to the WTA PO Box. There will be no withdraws nor refunds without a written request to WTA post marked at least one week prior to the date (original) date. There will be no refunds if the shoot is moved to the rain date.

All decisions regarding the interpretation of the shoot and the conduct of the shoot will be made by WTA management and are binding on all entrants.

Only new factory loads consistent with ATA rules are allowed. Shooters will be disqualified with no refund for using reloads.

Kitchen will be open for lunch.
